Castle Air Museum is a military aviation museum located in Atwater, California a former United States Air Force Strategic Air Command base, which was closed in 1995, after the end of the Cold War. It is one of the largest aerospace museums displaying vintage aircraft in the western United States.

At the Castle Air Museum there are 25 acres of a variety of restored aircraft and Air Force One! We will have 2 docents to guide us through our learning.

Hilmar Cheese founded in 1984, annually produces more cheese and whey from one site than any other manufacturer in the world, and employs more than 1,200 people. The company produces more than 21 million pounds of milk (9.5 million liters) of milk each day and receives milk from more than 230 dairies, producing more than 2.4 million pounds of cheese each day. Much of their cheese is found in stores under various name brands.

Lunch is on your own at Hilmar Cheese. (Upon arrival we will order our lunch from the deli, then take our tour and participate in cheese making. We will enjoy our lunch after the tour then depart, heading back to MJC West).
