From Felton the train travels from the Santa Cruz Mountains, through Henry Cowell Redwoods State Park, down the scenic San Lorenzo River Gorge, across a 1909 steel truss bridge and through an 1875 tunnel before arriving at the Santa Cruz Beach Boardwalk.

The Santa Cruz Big Trees & Pacific Railway operates passenger and freight services on one of the oldest and most historic lines in California. When the route opened in 1875 it carried lumber as well as picnickers and tourists to the Big Trees and Santa Cruz.

Our MICL Beach Train passengers will start and end their roundtrip journey, to the beach boardwalk in Santa Cruz, from Roaring Camp in Felton.
