Located approximately eight miles west of Modesto, the approximately 1,600-acre Dos Rios Ranch State Park has much to boast about: it is California's first new state park unit in nearly a decade, is the largest public-private floodplain restoration project in California history and is heralded as the future of conservation in California.

The 2-hour, free excursion, will be a guided walking tour over a dirt pathway. You will learn about the history of the project and about the various birds, trees, plants and flood plains.
